The roots and nature of the Goa carnival, dating back to the ancient Rome and Greece. These kind of carnivals were begun in the Spanish and Portuguese colonies, which became famous for their music, dance and drink. Apart from Goa the carnival is not celebrated anywhere in India, and once its popularity was declined even in Goa. With the Liberation of Goa, the carnival got a new initiative, and now its draws large number of tourists.
